ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, the Service Rules for Andhra Pradesh Indian Medicines & Homoeopathy Services were issued based on the recommendations made by the One Man Commission appointed in G.O.Rt.No. 4433, General Administration Department, dt.04/12/1986.

2. The Director, Indian Medicines and Homoeopathy in his letter second read above has reported that there are certain other suggestions to the Andhra Pradesh Indian Medicines and Homoeopathy Service Rules and furnished proposals for amendments to the said Rules.

3. The Government after careful examination of the matter and after review the proposal of the Commissioner, Andhra Pradesh Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy Department have decided to issue separate Revised Special Rules in respect of the Andhra Pradesh Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy Administration Service.

4. Accordingly, the following notification will be published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette:

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the

SPECIAL RULES

1. **SHORT TITLE:** These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh AYUSH Administration Service Rules.
2. **CONSTITUTION:** The Service shall consist of the following classes/categories of the posts in the Andhra Pradesh AYUSH Administration Service.

CLASS - A :

Category : Commissioner / Director ... Cadre post (Common category in Ayurveda / Unani / Homoeopathy)

CLASS - B :

Category-I : Deputy Director (Admn.)

Category-II : a) Administrative Officer
b) Accounts Officer
c) Lay Secretary & Treasurer Grade-II

3. METHOD OF APPOINTMENT :

Subject to the other provisions in these rules, the method of appointment for the categories shall be as follows :

4. RESERVATION IN APPOINTMENT :

In the method of appointment by transfer and in promotions the Rule 22 and 22-A of the A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules and instructions / orders issued there under from time to time shall be followed.

5. No person shall be eligible for appointment to classes/categories specified in Column (1), by the method specified in Column (2), unless he possess the qualifications specified in the corresponding entry in Column (3) thereof.

a) Administrative Officer b) Accounts Officer c) Lay Secretary & Treasurer Grade-II	By appointment by transfer	i) Must possess a Bachelors, Degree in any discipline from any University in India established or incorporated by or under a Central Act or State Act or Provincial Act or Institutions recognized by the University Grants Commission. ii) Must have passed Accounts Test for Executive Officers or Accounts Test for Subordinate Officers Part I & II.

6. MINIMUM SERVICE:

No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer or promotion unless he is an approved probationer and has put in not less than three years of service in the feeder category from which promotion or appointment by transfer is made.

7. APPOINTING AUTHORITY:

The Appointing Authority in respect of all the posts of Class-B shall be the Commissioner, Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy.

8. PROBATION:

Every person appointed to any of the posts either by promotion or by transfer shall be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years from the date on which one commences probation.

9. TESTS:

No person shall be eligible for promotion or appointment by transfer to any post in the service, unless he has passed the Accounts Test for Executive Officers or Accounts Test for Subordinate Officers Part-I and II.

10. UNIT OF APPOINTMENT:

For the purpose of appointment, discharge, for want of service

11. POSTING AND TRANSFERS:

The authority competent to posting and transfers of Officers in respect of all categories under Class B shall be the Commissioner / Director, Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy and the orders, instructions and guidelines issued by the Government from time to time shall be followed.
