The following Notification will be published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette:

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of the special rules issued in G.O.Ms.No.2672, Home, dated: the 13th December, 1966 and in G.O.Ms.No.1352, Home, dated: the 24th July, 1962, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Boilers Service:-

RULES

1. Short Title and commencement:

(1) These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Boilers Service Rules.

2. Constitution:

The Service shall consist of the following categories of posts in the Andhra Pradesh Boilers Service.

- Category (1): Director of Boilers;
- Category (2): Deputy Chief Inspector of Boilers,
- Category (3): Inspector of Boilers;

3. Method of Appointment:

The method of appointment to the above categories shall be as follows:-

Sl.No.	Category	Method of Appointment:
(1)	(2)	(3)
1.	Director of Boilers.	By promotion from category 2.
2.	Deputy Chief Inspector of Boilers.	By promotion from category 3.
3.	Inspector of Boilers.	By direct recruitment

4. Reservation of Appointment:

Except in so far as it relates to physically handicapped persons the rule of reservation of appointments (General Rule 22) shall apply to the appointments by direct recruitment to the post of Inspector of Boilers.

5. Qualifications:

No person shall be eligible for appointment to the category specified in column(1) of the Annexure to these rules by the method specified in the corresponding entry in column(2) thereof, unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entry in column(3) thereof:-

6. Age:

No candidate shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment if he has completed twenty eight years of age on the first day of July of the year in which the notification for selection is made.

7. Minimum Service:

No member of the service shall be eligible for promotion to the next higher category of post unless he has put in not less than three years of service after the date of commencement of his probation, in the category from which promotion is made.

8. Probation:

(a) A person appointed to any of the posts by direct recruitment shall be on probation for a total period of two years within a continuous period of three years from the date of which he commences his probation.

(b) A person appointed to any of the posts by promotion shall be on probation for a total period of one year within a continuous period of two years from the date on which he commences his probation.

9. Tests:

Every person appointed as Inspector of Boilers by direct recruitment, shall during the period of probation pass the Labour, Factories and Boilers Departmental Test Part D.
