

175. The Andhra Pradesh Police (Printing) Service Rules

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Police (Printing) Service.

Rule 1. Short title :—These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Police (Printing) Service Rules.

Rule 2. Constitution :—The service shall consist of the following categories of posts in the Andhra Pradesh (Printing) Service.

Category (1) : Deputy Superintendent of Police (Printing)

Category (2) : Inspector of Police (Printing)

Rule 3. Method of appointment and appointing authority :—Subject to the other provisions of these rules, the method of appointment and appointing authority for the several categories of posts shall be as follows :

<i>S. No.</i>	<i>Category</i>	<i>Method of Appointment</i>
1.	Deputy Superintendent of Police (Printing).	(i) By promotion of Inspector of Police (Printing). (ii) If the Inspector of Police (Printing) is not suitable or eligible or available for promotion by transfer, on tenure of an Assistant Director (Technical) from the Government Printing Department or Government Text Book Press.
2.	Inspector of Police (Printing).	By appointment by transfer of Sub-Inspector of Police (Printing).

Rule 4. Minimum Service :—No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer or promotion unless he is an approved probationer and has put in not less than three years of service in the category from which promotion or appointment by transfer is made.

Rule 5. Probation :—Every person appointed to any of the posts either by promotion or appointment by transfer shall from the date on which he commences probation, be on probation for a period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.

Rule 6. Tests :—No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Printing) or Inspector of Police (Printing) unless he/she has passed the Accounts Test for Subordinate Officers, Part-I and II or the Accounts Test for Executive Officers.
