

## SMALL SAVINGS

### 201. The Andhra Pradesh Small Savings Service Rules

*[G.O.Ms.No. 83, Finance and Planning (F.W.N.S.), Dt. 1-3-1994,  
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In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Small Savings Service.

**Rule 1. Short title** :—These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Small Savings Service Rules.

**Rule 2. Constitution** :—The Andhra Pradesh Small Savings Service shall consist of the following categories of posts :

Category (1) — Commissioner of Small Savings.

Category (2) — Deputy Commissioner including Assistant State Commissioner.

Category (3) — Deputy Director.

Category (4) — Assistant Director (Publicity).

Category (5) — Accounts Officer.

Category (6) — Special Tahsildar.

**Rule 3. Method of appointment** :—Subject to the other provisions in these rules, the method of appointment to the categories of posts shall be as follows :

Category (1)	Method of appointment (2)
(1) Commissioner	By posting of an I.A.S. Officer.
(2) Deputy Commissioner including Asst. State Commissioner.	By transfer on tenure basis of a Special Grade Dy. Collector, of the Revenue Department ; or By deputation of a Regional Director of National Savings Organisation, Government of India.
(3) Deputy Director	By transfer on tenure basis of a Deputy Collector of the Revenue Department ; or By deputation of a Deputy Regional Director of National Savings Organisation, Government of India.
(4) Assistant Director (Publicity)	By transfer on tenure basis of an Assistant Director of the Information and Public Relations Department.
(5) Accounts Officer	(i) By transfer on tenure basis of an Accounts Officer of Finance and Planning (Fin. Wing) Department.

<i>Category</i> (1)	<i>Method of appointment</i> (2)
(6) Special Tahsildar	(ii) If no qualified and suitable person is available by method (i) above, by transfer on tenure basis or an Accounts Officer of the Treasuries and Accounts Department. : By transfer on tenure basis of a Mandal Revenue Officer of the rank of Tahsildar of the Revenue Department or of a Mandal Development Officer of the Panchayat Raj Department.

**Rule 4. Period of tenure/deputation** :—The appointment on tenure basis or on deputation to any of the post in this service shall not ordinarily be for more than three years at a time :

Provided that nothing in this rule shall preclude the Government or the Commissioner of Small Savings, as the case may be, to repatriate the Officers drafted on tenure basis or on deputation to their parent department, before the expiry of the period of tenure or on deputation if it is considered necessary, in the public interest.
