

These include development of the Quality Assessment Guidelines, setting up a 3<sup>rd</sup> party agency with a proactive and effective fraud control and detection capability and conducting quality assessment for empaneled hospitals

In this regard, Government has decided to assess the standards and quality of all the network hospitals through a 3<sup>rd</sup> party as per the norms and guidelines laid down by the Trust.

In view of the above, all the network hospitals under Dr.YSR AHCT are hereby informed that the quality assessment will be initiated **from 15.10.2019** and grading the hospitals will be given **as A+, A and B** based on the identified parameters as mentioned below:

<b>A</b>	<b>Health Infrastructure</b>
A.1	Certification / Documentation
A.2	Equipment / Kiosk availability
A.3	Mandatory staff as per requirement
<b>B</b>	<b>Hospitality Standards</b>
B.1	Maintenance / Hygiene
B.2	Patient satisfaction assessment

Hence, all the network hospitals are informed to extend your cooperation to the concerned officials in conducting quality assessment of your hospital.
