NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.1763, Public Works Department, dated the 15th July 1965 the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Engineering (Research Laboratories) Subordinate Service.

RULES

1. Short title:

These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Engineering (Research Laboratories) Subordinate Service Rules, 2006.

2. CONSTITUTION:

**I. METHOD OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTING AUTHORITY :**

Subject to the other provisions in these rules, the method of appointment and appointing authority for the categories of posts shall be as follows:

Note 1 : In the matter of appointment to the post of Observer (Engineering), the following method shall be observed.

Observers

(i) For Engineering Sections:

Direct Recruitment : Such Number of Vacancies as the State Government may from time to time determine; not exceeding 50% of the total number of vacancies shall be filled by direct recruitment

(ii) Transfer: 50% of the vacancies shall be filled by transfer on tenure from the category of Assistant Engineers in the I&CAD Department.

NOTE -- 2 : In direct recruitment to the post of Observer (Engineering) the persons possessing a Degree in Mechanical Engineering or Electrical Engineering shall not exceed 10% of the total posts.

NOTE-3(a): 30% of the substantive vacancies in the category of Computer shall be filled by direct recruitment.

(b) 70% of the vacancies in the category of Computer, shall be filled by promotion of Assistant Computers

NOTE-4(a): 50% of the substantive vacancies in the category of Draughtsman Grade-III shall be filled by direct recruitment.

(b) 50% of the vacancies the post of Draughtsman Grade-III shall be filled by the promotion of Tracer.

Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing notes, the seniority of persons appointed by different methods to the posts shall be determined with reference to General rule 33 of the Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996.

#### 4. QUALIFICATIONS :

No person shall be eligible for appointment to the categories specified in Coloum (1) to the Annexure to these rules by the method specified in Column (2) unless he possess the qualifications specified in the corresponding entry in Column (3) thereof.

5. RESERVATION OF APPOINTMENT :

- (i) The rule of special representation as provided in A.P.State and Subordinate Service Rules shall apply to all appointments made by direct recruitment/ promotion to the various categories of posts in this service.
- (ii) There shall be reservation of 2% to the category of Ex-service men.

6. AGE :

No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment, if he has completed 33 years of age on the first day of July of the year in which the notification for selection is made. Age relaxation for ST/SC/BC/PH/Ex-Service men will be applicable as in force from time to time.

7. MINIMUM SERVICE :

Unless otherwise mentioned else where in these rules, no person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer or promotion unless he has put in not less than three (3) years of service in the category from which promotion or transfer is made.

8. PROBATION :

- (a) Every person appointed by direct recruitment to any of the posts shall, from the date on which he commences probation, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.
- (b) Every person appointed to any of the posts either by promotion or by transfer shall, from the date on which he commences promotion, be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.

TRANSFERS AND POSTINGS :

The appointing authorities specified in column (3) in the Table in rule 3 shall be competent to effect the transfers and postings of persons in the respective categories.
