NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following Adhoc Rules for the temporary post of Administrative Officer in the Office of the Advocate General, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad.

ADHOC RULES

1. Short title: These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Advocate Generals' Gazette Establishment service rules, 1999
2. Constitution: The service shall consist of the post of Administrative Officer in the Office of the Advocate General, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad
3. Method of appointment: Appointment to the post shall be made by transfer from the category of,-
 - (1) Manager/Section Officer in the Andhra Pradesh Ministerial Service in the Advocate-Generals' Establishment; or
 - (2) Secretary (Gazetted) in Public Prosecutors' Office, High Court of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad.
4. Appointing Authority: The appointing authority for the post shall be the Secretary to Government, Legal Affairs, Law Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad.
5. Minimum Service: No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer unless he is an approved probationer and has put in not less than 3 years of service but no case shall be less than 2 years of service in the category from which such appointment by transfer is made.

ii) If no qualified and suitable candidate is available by the above method, by transfer/by deputation on tenure basis of P.A. to the Judges in the A.P. High Court Service. Advocate General

4. Minimum Service;

No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer or on promotion unless he has put in not less than three years of service in the category from which appointment by transfer is made.

5. Probation;

Every person appointed by transfer shall, from the date on which he commences probation be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.
