Sub:DR NTR VST-AP-Hyd-certain modified guidelines issued regarding authenticity of the beneficiary of card holders of RAP/TAP/WAP and Child beneficiaries-reg.

Ref: 1.This office Circular Rc.No.AST/1213/Circular/2010-11dated 22/01/2011issued to all the Network Hospitals.

2.This Office Circular Rc.No.1408/AHCT/F-25/2013 dated 18/03/2013 dated 18/03/2013 addressed to all the Network Hospitals and all District Coordinators in the state.

In the reference 1st cited following guidelines have been issued relating to identification of the beneficiaries who have been issued Temporary Household cards during Rachabanda programme held from 24/01/2011 to 12/02/2011 for availing benefits under Aarogyasri scheme.(presently Dr NTR Vaidya Seva)

1.The card number will start with TAP

2.The card will have 15 digits.First 3 digits are TAP(Temporary Andhra Pradesh),next 2 digits will be the code of the district,the next 2 digits the code of the mandal,next 4digits the FP Shop number and the last 4 numbers will be the consumer code.

3.The data of these card holders will be available in the card search option in www.aarogyasri.org.

4.The photograph of the beneficiary /Family will not be available in Temporary Household card issued by the Government.In order to identify the patient with the photograph the following guidelines are to be followed.

Elective cases: In case of elective cases the beneficiary has to submit the Temporary household card along with the certificate for identification of Beneficiary under Rajiv Aarogyasri Health Insurance scheme issued by the District Collector (AnnexureIII).The Certificate for Identification of Beneficiary under Rajiv Aarogyasri Health Insurance scheme will have the photograph of the beneficiary /Family attested by the District Collector.


Emergency Cases: For emergency cases instead of identification of Beneficiary under Rajiv Aarogyasri Health Insurance scheme ,the beneficiary should be allowed to submit any of the 16 photo identity proof mentioned below.The beneficiary has to submit the below mentioned ID proofs within 48 hours from the time of taking the telephonic approval along with the Temporary Household card .

In order to reduce the physical burden for the card holders of RAP/TAP/WAP to approach the MRO office and from then to District Collectors office, to avoid procedural delay and also to reduce the expenditure towards printing of the beneficiary Books, the existing procedure of issuing certificate by District Collector for identification of the beneficiary of RAP/WAP/TAP Cards is

dispensed with and in place of that the beneficiary has to submit any of the valid photo identity cards such as Aadhar Card, Election Photo Identity Card, Driving Licence for authenticity of the patient for availing the benefits under Dr NTR Vaidya Seva. This procedure is applicable for both elective cases and Emergency cases.

Further in modification of the guidelines issued earlier in the reference 2nd cited regarding providing treatment to patient of paediatric age under Aarogyasri without his his/her name in any card like WAP/RAP/TAP etc., now it is decided to consider Birth certificate/Delivery certificate/Discharge certificate along with the parent declaration form as certificate of proof for the identity of the child for availing treatment under DR NTR Vaidya Seva.

Accordingly above changes have been made in Dr NTR Vaidya Seva portal and above guidelines may be followed without fail.
